SUBJECT : **Memorandum 2021-001**
Reiteration of TRANSFER OF TECHNICAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Greetings!

This is to reiterate the implementation of the PBOG policy on TRANSFER OF TECHNICAL RESPONSIBILITIES from year 2021 to 2022:

- Of the *twenty-five (25)* cases of major Ob-Gyn procedures with varied indications (15 Primary cesarean sections, five repeat CS and five major gynecologic procedures), a **maximum of 70% TTR** cases is permissible for the year 2021 up to 2022 (or, a maximum of 17 TTR cases). At least *30%* of the 25 cases (or 8 cases) should have been managed as 'OWN cases' by the candidate (the applicant as "primary doctor/ surgeon").
- Of the *thirty-five (35)* major Ob-Gyn cases specified by the PBOG (which include 15 total abdominal hysterectomies), a **maximum of 70% TTR** cases is allowed for the year 2021 up to 2022 (or, a maximum of 24 TTR cases). At least *eleven (11)* cases or *30%* of the 35 cases should have been managed by the candidate as 'OWN cases' (the applicant as "primary doctor/surgeon").

- ***Effective year 2023, allowed TTR cases for submission will be down to 40% only (or, 10 TTR cases only of the first 25 major cases), from 70% of the 25 cases. 'OWN' cases required will be 60%* of the total 25 (or, 15 cases).***

- ***Beginning year 2023, submitted TTR cases to be accepted among the 35 major cases specified by the PBOG will be down to only 40% of total # required (or, only 14 TTR cases). Sixty* per cent (60%) will have to be cases 'OWNED' by the applicant (or, a total of 21 'OWN' cases).***
