

BALDOMERO ROXAS MEMORIAL LECTURER AND AWARDEE FOR ACADEMIC DISTINCTION

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be outstanding in the field of academic Obstetrics & Gynecology
2. Must be a Fellow of the POGS for at least 15 years.
3. Must have rendered meritorious service to the society.
4. Must have contributed outstanding works in Philippine Obstetrics & Gynecology
5. Must be of good moral standing
6. Must deliver the Memorial Lecture during the Annual Convention.

CRITERIA:

- A. HE/SHE MUST BE OUTSTANDING (MARKED BY EMINENCE AND DISTINCTION) IN THE FIELD OF ACADEMIC OBSTETRICS AND GYNECOLOGY (85 points).
1. Dedication to teaching. (1 point for every year of teaching; maximum of 20 points)
 2. Must have attained high academic rank. (maximum of 30 points)
 - a. Full Professor in OB-GYN 15 points
 - b. Professor Emeritus or Ph.D. 5 points
 - c. Chairman of an accredited OB-GYN Department 5 points
 - d. Dean of College of Medicine 5points
 3. Must have received special honors or recognition in academic excellence. (5 points each; maximum of 20 points)
 - a. Outstanding Medical alumnus 5 points
 - b. Outstanding Faculty in OB-GYN 5 points
 - c. Outstanding Physician of a Medical Society/
Local Sub-Specialty Society 5 points
 - d. Professorial Chair holder 5 points
 - e. Keynote speaker or panelist in national and/or
international scientific congresses/conventions 5 points
 - f. National and/or International Award 5 points
 4. Must have contributed significant works in OB-GYN (maximum of 15 points)
 - a. Published researches in peer-reviewed journals
International journals: 2 points for each paper
Philippine journals: 1 point for each paper
 - b. Authored, edited, or contributed chapters in books in OB-GYN or related specialties
Author/Editor/Co-editor: 10 points per book
Chapter contributor: 2 points per chapter

- c. Authored in published Clinical Practice Guidelines. 1 point
- d. Introduced/pioneered innovative ideas, diagnostic tests, treatments, procedures, and/or instruments. 5 points

B. HE/SHE MUST HAVE RENDERED MERITORIOUS SERVICES TO THE POGS (maximum of 15 points)

- 1. Must have been President or Officer of the Society.
 - As President 7.5 points
 - As officer or member of the Board of Trustees 2.5 points
- 2. Must have been Chairman or Member of PBOG and/or CREED.
 - As Chairman 5 points
 - As Member 1 point for every year of service, maximum of 3 points
- 3. Must have been participating in POGS CME Activities
 - As speaker/lecturer in postgraduate courses or scientific meetings 1 point/occasion, maximum of 5 points
- 4. President of POGS Affiliated Specialty Societies. 2 points

A minimum of seventy-five (75) points must be obtained to merit the award.

POGS AWARD OF EXCELLENCE IN CLINICAL PRACTICE

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be outstanding in the field of CLINICAL PRACTICE of Obstetrics and Gynecology.
2. Must have been acknowledged by the Regional Director.
3. Must be a Fellow of POGS in good standing with good moral and ethical values.

CRITERIA:

1. The number of years of practice must be 30 years or more. (70 points)
2. Must be active in the local chapter of POGS and its Continuing Medical Education (CME) Activities (10 points)
3. Social & Civic Works (5 points)
4. Innovative ideas, devices, surgical techniques, systems, methods, diagnostic tests relative to clinical practice and local situations. (15 points)

A minimum of seventy-five (75) points must be obtained to merit the award.

RAMON LOPEZ AWARD OF MERIT FOR COMMUNITY SERVICE

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must have rendered and submitted his/her outstanding meritorious community work.
2. Must have documented active participation in Community Medical Outreach Programs.
3. Must be a POGS Fellow in good standing for at least 15 years.
4. Must be a person of good moral values.

CRITERIA:

1. He / She must have rendered meritorious community services for at least five (5) years. (60 points)
 - 1.1 POGS initiated. (40 points)
 - 1.2 Non POGS initiated and collaborated. (20 points)
2. He / She must be outstanding practitioner in Obstetrics and Gynecology, marked by eminence and distinction. (25 points)
 - 2.1 Must have attained prestigious position in his field of practice.
 - 2.1.1 President of a Medical Society (Specialty, Sub-Specialty, Local, National or International). (10 points)
 - 2.1.2 Other positions in the Medical Society. (5 points)
 - 2.2 Recipient of a special award or distinctions and recognitions granted by a medical society, socio civic organization, government and non-government or other entities. (10 points)
3. Must have documented active participation in community medical outreach programs and/or social advocacy. (3 points per program; maximum of 15 points)

A minimum of seventy-five (75) points must be obtained to merit the award

HONORIA ACOSTA-SISON AWARD OF MERIT FOR RESEARCH

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must have outstanding OB-GYN research papers/books published.
2. Must be a Fellow of POGS in good standing for at least 15 years.
3. Must be an active participant in CME, Research and other Scientific Activities of the POGS.
4. Must be a person of good moral values.

CRITERIA:

1. Must have scientific papers published in peer-reviewed medical journals. (60 points)

In Philippine journals	10 points per paper
In international journals	10 points per paper
2. Must be author, editor or chapter contributor in books and handbooks. (30 points)
 - a. Books (maximum of 20 points)

Editor	10 points per book
Chapter contributor	5 points per chapter
 - b. Handbook (maximum of 10 points) (CPGs included)

Editor	5 points per handbook
Chapter contributor	3 points per chapter
3. Memberships in editorial boards of peer-reviewed journals. (maximum of 10 points)
 - a. Editor-in-Chief of Philippine Journal of Obstetrics and Gynecology or other DOST recognized journal in OB-GYN 4 points for each membership
 - b. In Philippine journals 2 points for each membership
 - c. In International journals 4 points for each membership

A minimum of seventy-five (75) points must be obtained to merit the award

CONSTANTINO P. MANAHAN YOUNG RESEARCHER AWARD

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must have outstanding OB-GYN Research Papers done and published beyond residency.
2. Must be 40 years of age and below at the time of nomination.
3. Must be a Diplomate / Fellow of POGS in good standing.
4. Must be a person of good moral values.

CRITERIA:

1. Must have outstanding OB-GYN Research Papers published. (70 points)
 - a. Should have at least one (1) Research Paper published in an International Journal or three (3) papers (original) published in the POGS Journal or other local journals of wide circulation. (40 points)
 - b. Have been awarded first (15 points) / second (5 points) prize winner in any of the Research Paper contest. (20 points)
 - c. Recipient of Research grants. (10 points)
2. Presented his major Research work in appropriate fora, seminar or congress. (15 points)
3. Must be an active member of Scientific, Academic Professional Organizations. (15 points)

A minimum of seventy-five (75) points must be obtained to merit the award
