
ALGORITHM FOR THE DIPLOMATE CERTIFICATION PROCESS PART 1 (WRITTEN)



SUBMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR EXAMINATION

(SEE PBOG UPDATED DOWLOADABLE FORMS AND APPLICATION DEPENDING ON CATEGORY)



FIRST TIME APPLICATION

Fifty (50) Required cases

- 25 Major OB
- 17 Major GYN
- 8 Other GYN procedures
 - All done within the last 5 years
 - Tabulation (Check PBOG Downloadable forms)

During the pandemic (2020-2022) 70 % TTR 30 % OWNED allowed for all cases (including vaginal breech, CS hysterectomy, suction of H. mole)

REPEAT APPLICATION OR RE-EXAMINATION

A. REPEAT WITHIN 1 - 2 Years AFTER 1ST FAILURE:

 Four (4) Certificates of Attendance in POGS accredited webinars or Conferences OR Recent POGS convention

B. 3 YEARS AFTER 1ST FAILED PART 1 (and for every failure thereafter):

- Five (5) MAJOR cases: Three (3) OB and Two (2) GYN
 - All cases done within 5 years prior to application (but after residency)
 - Applicant as primary surgeon
 - All varied indications/procedures

During the pandemic Attendance to Conferences

- Four (4) Certificates of attendance to in POGS accredited conference or webinars
- OR the Recent POGS (annual or midyear) convention

REPEAT PART 1 APPLICATION AFTER FAILING PART 2 Three (3) times OR WITH EXPIRED JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP


Ten (10) MAJOR OB-GYN Procedures and cases

- with Six (6) OB and Four (4) GYN
 - All cases done within the last two years
 - Varied indications/ procedures
 - Applicant as primary surgeon

During the pandemic Attendance to Conferences

- Four (4) Certificates of attendance to in POGS accredited conference or webinars
- OR the Recent POGS (annual or midyear) convention





- Resubmit according to PBOG Recommendations
- Must resubmit within one year (2 years in the pandemic) during the period of application for the Part 1 exam, using previously unsubmitted or new cases
- If submitted more than one year (2 years in the pandemic) during the period of application for the Part 1 exam, a new set of 50 cases will be required following PBOG Resolution 2021.04.06
